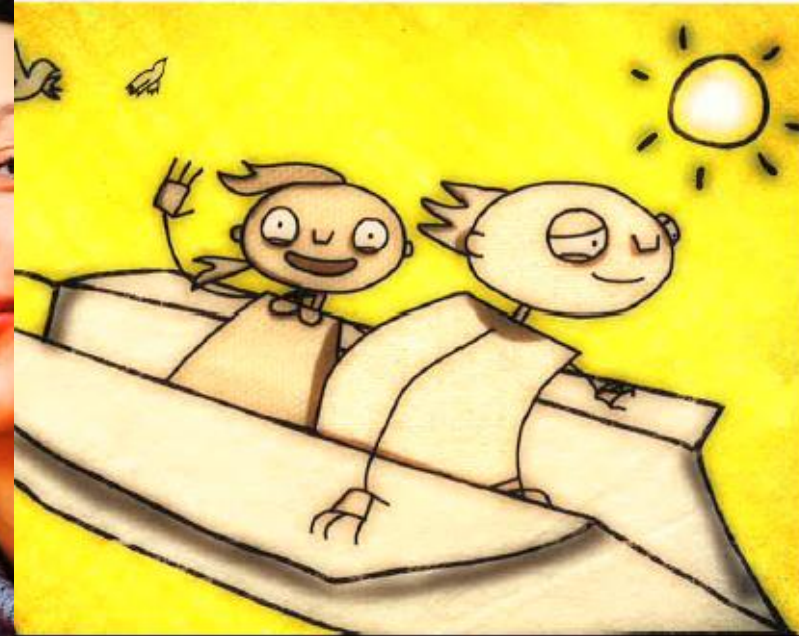

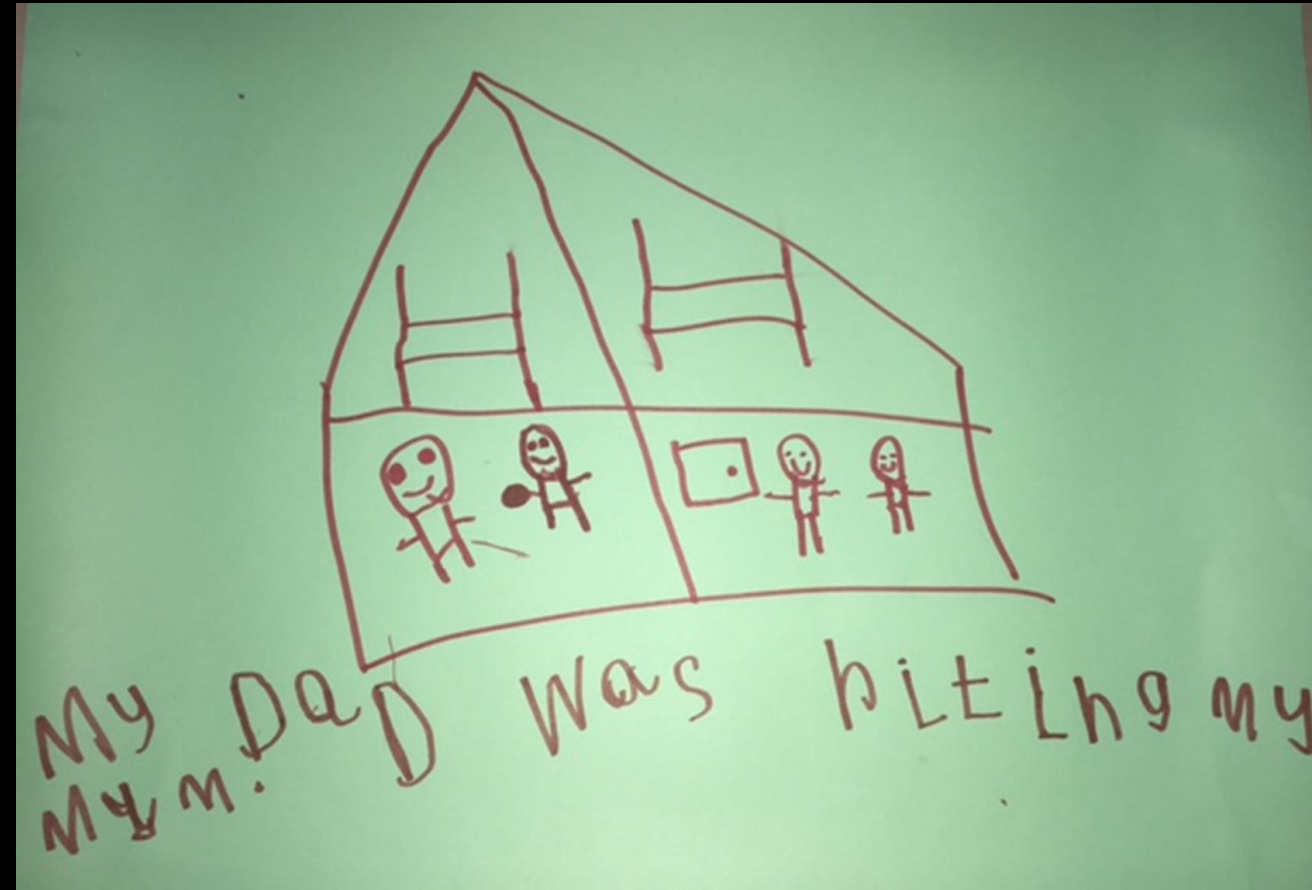

- Assessment as engagement
- Improving attachment
- Individual and community capacity
- Communication
- Peer learning



EYDAR Outcomes

- Mothers better understand the impact of domestic abuse on their child, improved relationship with their child and a greater sense of self-worth and wellbeing.
- Partner agencies better understand the complexity of domestic abuse and its impact on children, leading to improved multi-agency responses to domestic abuse.
- Babies, children and their mothers are at less risk of domestic abuse.



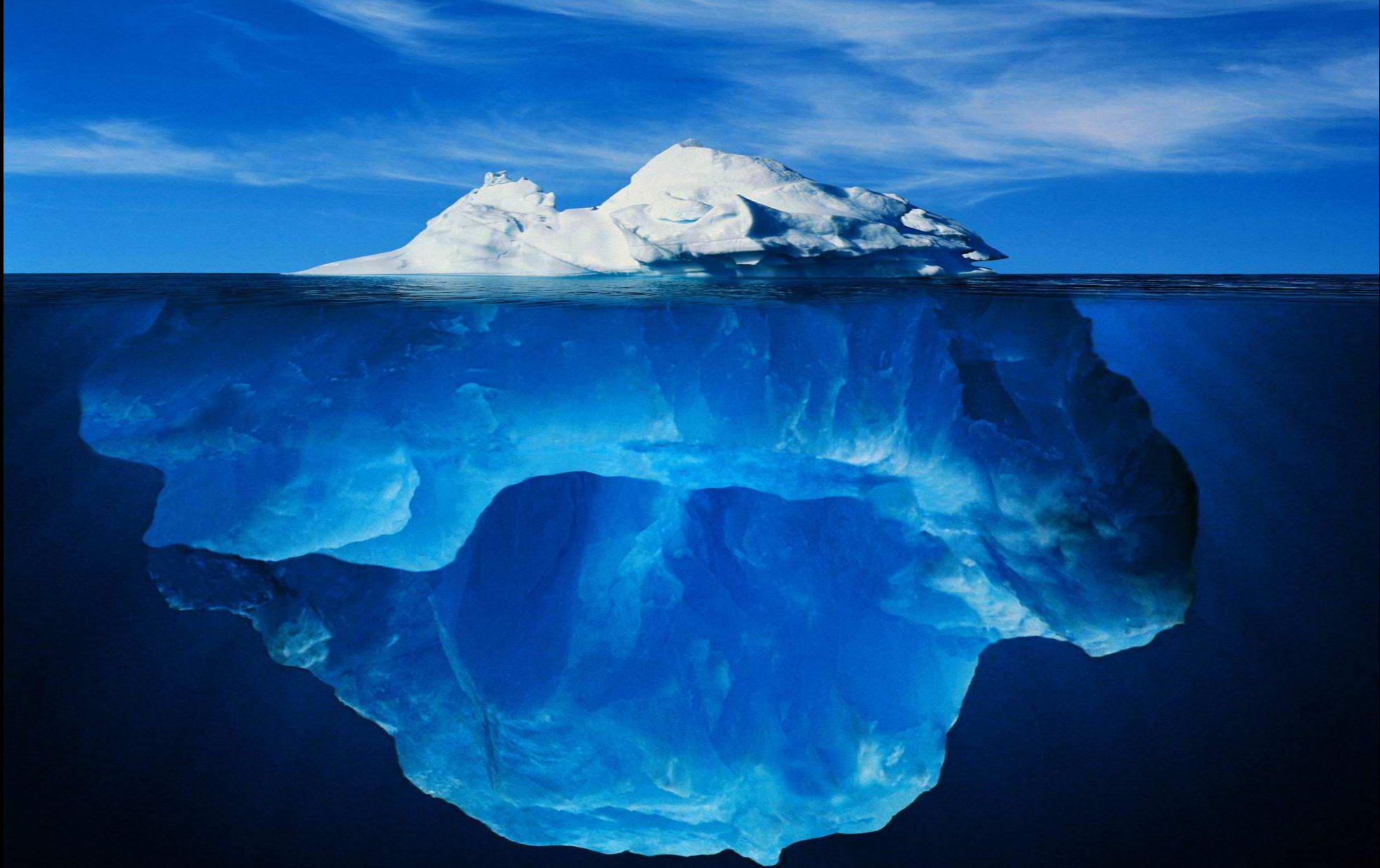

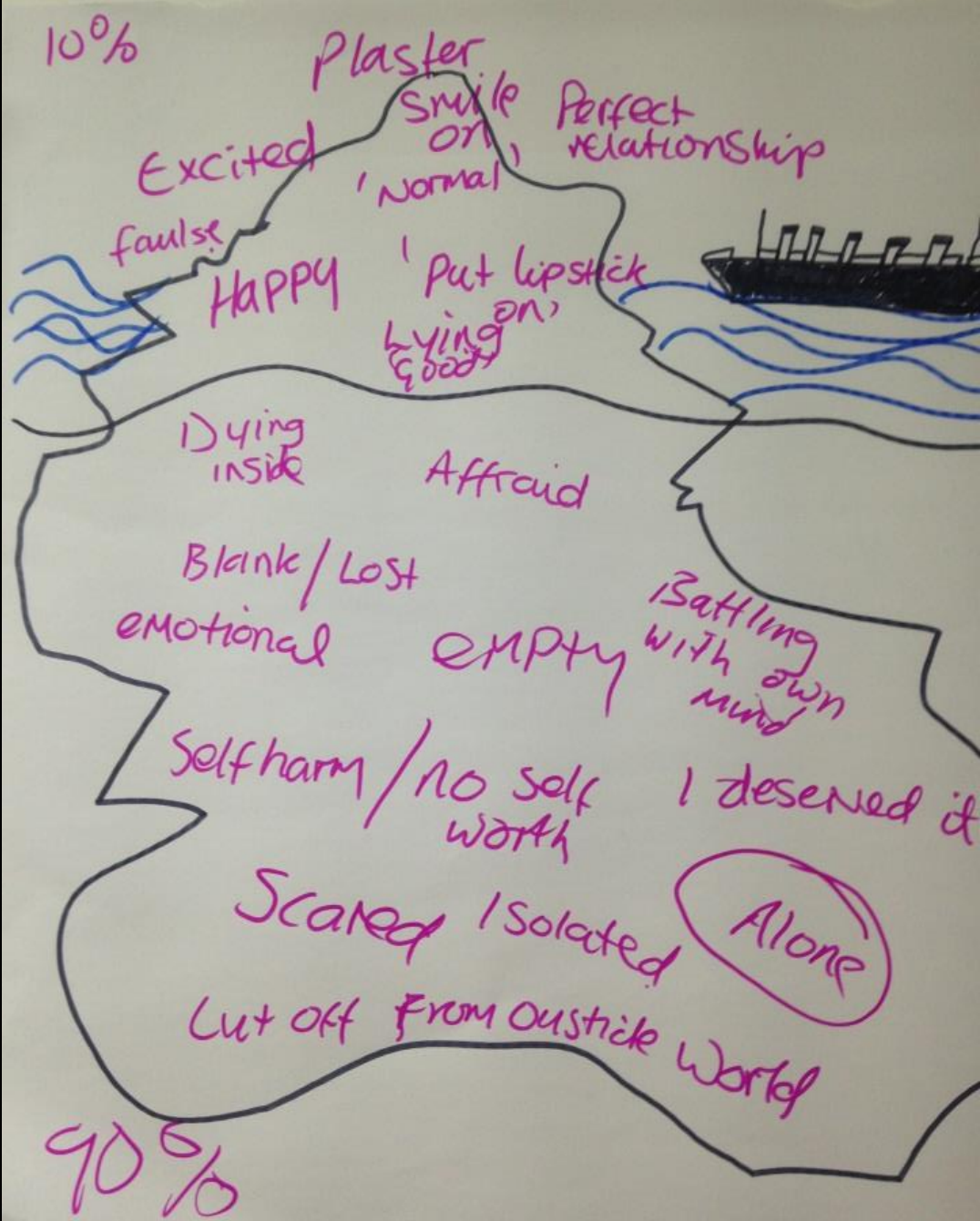

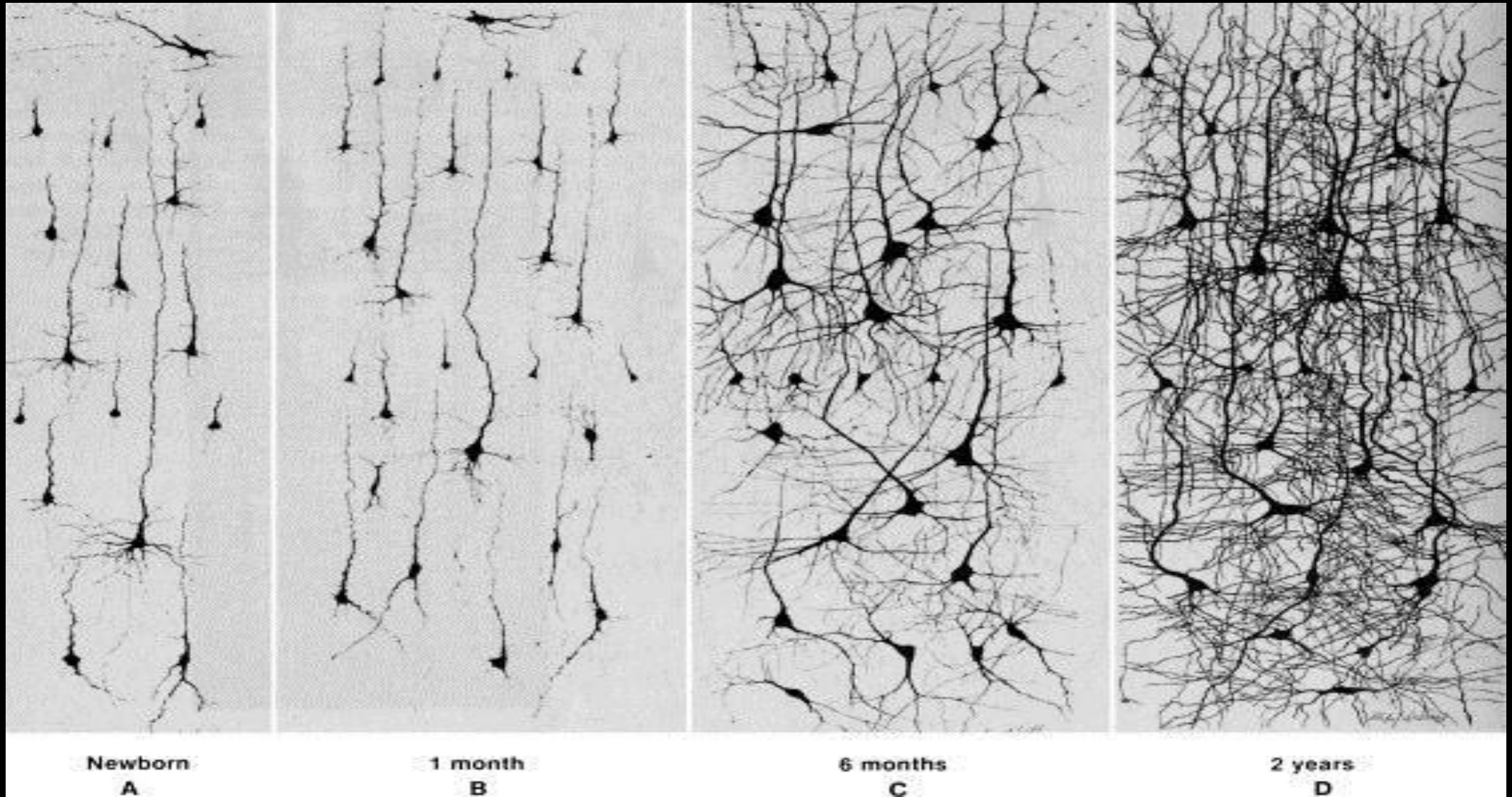

- Scared

- no interest in anyone

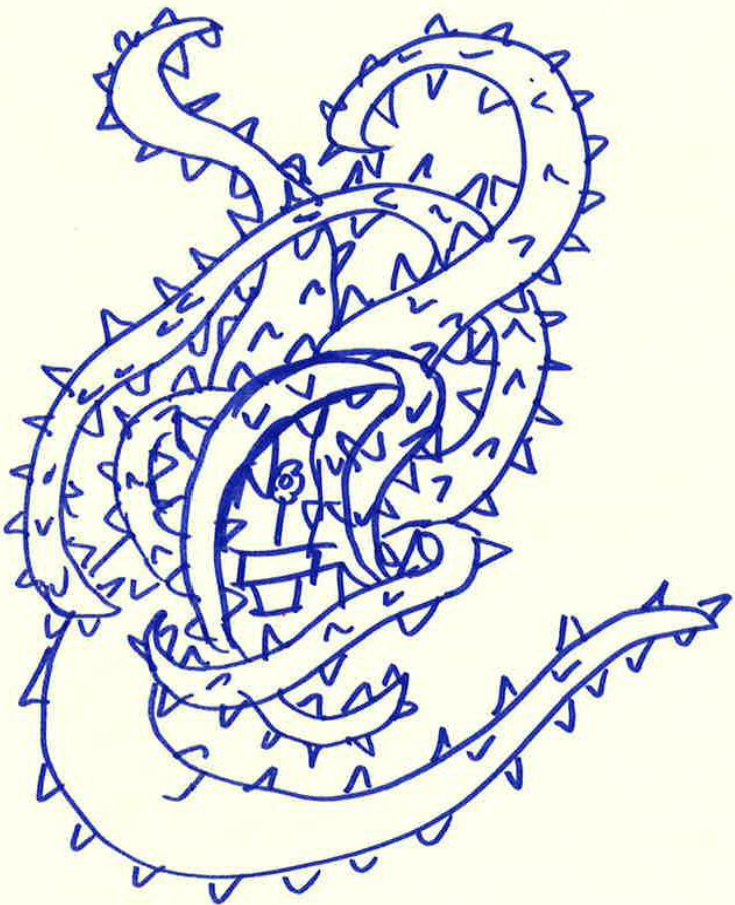
