We collect and process

- disciplinary and grievance records

Where necessary, we may hold more sensitive information about you, called "special category" personal data, including:

- information about your race or ethnicity, religious beliefs and sexual orientation (if you provide these) for the purposes of equalities monitoring
- information about your health for purposes of managing sickness absence and providing occupational health services and making reasonable adjustments
- where appropriate, information about criminal convictions and offences for authorised background checks, using information from the appropriate statutory bodies [Disclosure Scotland](#).
