

# Common Advice Performance Management Reporting Framework Summary 2018/19

## Dundee City Council



The Common Advice Performance Management Reporting Framework (CAPMRF) has been developed in consultation with local authorities and other key stakeholders. It aims to measure key performance indicators for welfare and money advice services funded by local authorities on both an in-house and commissioned basis. This is a summary of the key findings from the data returns for 2018/19 for the CAPMRF for Dundee City Council.

This is the second year in which the data has been collected in relation to both welfare and money advice services, making it possible to begin to identify changes over time at both local and national levels. Prior to 2017/18, three iterations, covering 2014/15 through to 2016/17, covered money advice only. Therefore, longer term trends can be examined for indicators covering money advice. The information received from individual local authorities has been collated in order to produce a Scotland-wide analysis reflecting the significant impact of welfare and money advice services at a national level. This should be considered in conjunction with this local summary. The key findings are detailed below:

### Key Points:

- The total number of clients accessing the services increased 2% from 10,720 in 2017/18 to 10,958 in 2018/19.
- The most common reason recorded as the first reason for contacting the agency was benefit entitlement checks which made up 33% of those recorded.
- There was a small decrease (1%) in the total amount owed by debt clients. This reduced from £3,747,438 in 2017/18 to £3,696,935 in 2018/19.
- A total of £15,256,005 financial gain was secured for clients in 2018/19. This has increased 26% since the previous year.
- In 2018/19 there was a total of 1,212 welfare benefit claims made, 287 mandatory reconsiderations and 124 appeals.
