Common Advice Performance Management Reporting Framework Summary 2018/19

## **Shetland Islands Council**









The Common Advice Performance Management Reporting Framework (CAPMRF) has been developed in consultation with local authorities and other key stakeholders. It aims to measure key performance indicators for welfare and money advice services funded by local authorities on both an in-house and commissioned basis. This is a summary of the key findings from the data returns for 2018/19 for the CAPMRF for Shetland Islands Council.

This is the second year in which the data has been collected in relation to both welfare and money advice services, making it possible to begin to identify changes over time at both local and national levels. Prior to 2017/18, three iterations, covering 2014/15 through to 2016/17, covered money advice only. Therefore, longer term trends can be examined for indicators covering money advice. The information received from individual local authorities has been collated in order to produce a Scotland-wide analysis reflecting the significant impact of welfare and money advice services at a national level. This should be considered in conjunction with this local summary. The key findings are detailed below:

## **Key Points:**

- In total 968 clients were supported in 2018/19 of which 946 were new clients to the service.
- There was a large proportion of clients who were recorded as permanently retired from work.
   These clients made up 39% of clients in comparison to just 16% of clients across Scotland recorded in this category. There was also a large proportion of Homeowners. These clients made up 41% of clients in Shetland but only 22% in Scotland.
- In total, debt owed by clients was £1,302,863, an increase from the last recorded figure in 2016/17 of £79,541 or 6.5%. Of the 268 clients who owed debt almost a quarter (64 or 24%) held credit, store and charge card debt, which was the highest proportion of types of debt. The next highest was rent arrears at 37 clients or 14% or all clients.
- In 2018/19 £1,485,840 financial gain was secured for clients, which was made up of £1,283,379 from awards made or maintained and £202,461 from mandatory reconsiderations/appeals.
