## Common Advice Performance Management Reporting Framework Summary 2018/19 South Lanarkshire Council









The Common Advice Performance Management Reporting Framework (CAPMRF) has been developed in consultation with local authorities and other key stakeholders. It aims to measure key performance indicators for welfare and money advice services funded by local authorities on both an in-house and commissioned basis. This is a summary of the key findings from the data returns for 2018/19 for the CAPMRF for South Lanarkshire Council.

This is the second year in which the data has been collected in relation to both welfare and money advice services, making it possible to begin to identify changes over time at both local and national levels. Prior to 2017/18, three iterations, covering 2014/15 through to 2016/17, covered money advice only. Therefore, longer term trends can be examined for indicators covering money advice. The information received from individual local authorities has been collated in order to produce a Scotland-wide analysis reflecting the significant impact of welfare and money advice services at a national level. This should be considered in conjunction with this local summary. The key findings are detailed below:

## Key Points:

- There was a 3% increase in local government expenditure in the internal Money Matters Advice services as result of the 2018/19 local government pay award.
- The majority of external referrals to the Money Matters Advice service come through Primary Health Care services. These referrals made up 15% of all referrals, which is comparatively higher than in Scotland where 9% are made through this pathway.
- Since 2017/18 the total number of clients seeking debt advice has increased 14%, with increases in clients seen across all but one debt type.
- The total amount of financial gain secured for clients has increased 10% to £32,484,526 in 2018/19. This includes £24,180,163 financial gain from benefit claims made/maintained, £4,681,474 from mandatory reconsiderations/appeals, £2,822,664 from money advice and additional welfare rights gain of £800,225.
