

# Key Questions

Considering the potential implications and impact of the scenario will help to inform actions that may be required. It is important to engage a diverse group in discussions, in order to get different perspectives and challenge thinking.

Below are some examples of questions that may be helpful to use in discussions to identify implications. It is not intended to be used as a list to work through, but as a prompt for questions that might be relevant. Choose only those most appropriate to the scenario.

- Who will be most affected by this and what might this look like for them?
- On a scale of 1-10, how much will this matter to them?
- What other groups and situations will be affected?
- How will this affect partners and other services?
- What will be different, what will we see?
- What else will change, are there any other consequences we can think of?
- How often do we think this will happen?
- How might this change over time?
- What other possible outcomes can you think of?
